WE the Freemen, Freeholders and Inhabitants of _______, being greatly Alarmed at the avowed Design of the U S government: To raise Revenue by means contrary to the Constitutional authority granted them; To enact contrary to the Constitutional authority granted them; and, To remove those Rights, granted by God and Preserved by the Constitution, Do in the most Solemn Manner resolve never to become Slaves to that government; and do associate under all the Ties of Religion, Honour, and Love to our Country, the United States of America, and under the authority of the Declaration of Independence, to adopt and endeavour to carry into Execution whatever Measures may be recommended by; and that we will in all things follow the Advice of our Committee respecting the purpose aforesaid, the preservation of Peace and good Order and the Safety of Individuals and private Property.
